

**The foundation arises.****1928**

Eugen Klöpfer founded an engineering office for electric materials in Dortmund.

**1938**

Eugen Klöpfer Ingenieurbüro took over the agencies of VOIGT & HAEFFNER AG, Frankfurt/Main and the transformer company KOCH & STERZEL AG, Dresden.

**1945**

After the war, the sales activities for Messrs. VOIGT & HAEFFNER AG were renewed. The contractual relations with KOCH & STERZEL AG could not be continued due to the separation of Germany.

**Extension of the spectrum.****1952**

Foundation of Infratherm GmbH, Dortmund, infrared radiators, electric convectors as well as thermal plants for the glass and mirror glass industry have been planned and manufactured later on.

**1953**

The CONTI-ELEKTRO AG was founded as sales organization with own branches. As a consequence, the agency of VOIGT & HAEFFNER AG expired. The Eugen Klöpfer Ingenieurbüro started the construction of control panels according to customer-specific requirements.

**1955**

The Infratherm GmbH traded under the name of Klöpfer Wärmetechnik GmbH now.

**1960**

The Klöpfer Wärmetechnik GmbH extended its manufacturing range by heat tracing and heat exchangers.

**1967**

The founder of the company, Eugen Klöpfer, passed away. Karl-Hugo Klöpfer-Waldmann took over the management of Eugen Klöpfer Ingenieurbüro and Klöpfer Wärmetechnik GmbH.

**1972**

Merger of Eugen Klöpfer Ingenieurbüro and Klöpfer Wärmetechnik GmbH in the limited partnership Eugen Klöpfer. Structuring of all activities in the field electrical engineering, heat technology and mechanical engineering.

**1976**

Nomination of Alfred Beimdick and Friedrich Hinz as managing directors.

**1977**

Partnership of Alfred Beimdick and Friedrich Hinz as limited partners.

**1978**

Participation and later takeover of Messrs. Huppertz & Schneider GmbH & Co., Waltrop, today's Hard- und Software Technologie GmbH & Co. KG (H&S), Dortmund.

**1979**

The first own production and administration building was erected for the company range electrical engineering, heat technology and mechanical engineering. It was extended in 1981 and 1984.

**1980**

Purchase and takeover of the management of Messrs. Elmess, today Elmess-Thermosystemtechnik GmbH & Co. KG, Uelzen.

**1982**

The main shareholder Karl-Hugo Klöpfer-Waldmann passed away. The company shares were transferred to the families Beimdick and Hinz.

**1986**

The business field heat technology was the first field that has been separated from Eugen Klöpfer GmbH & Co. KG and became independent under today's Klöpfer-Therm GmbH & Co. KG.

**1987**

Move into the new, modern, three-storey office with integrated workshop and warehouse at today's location in Dortmund-Wambel.

**1988**

Purchase of a further manufacturing hall, initially as central warehouse, later on as manufacturing hall for Klöpfer-Elektrotechnik and H&S.

**1994**

The manufacturing area was doubled by extension of a modern manufacturing hall.

**2000**

A new generation has taken over the company's management. Volker Hinz and Engelbert Brück were nominated as managing directors.

**2004**

Takeover of the cable type heater technology from Haldor Topsoe, Denmark, extension of the manufacturing area on the adjoining site.

**2007/2008**

extension of workshop and office area by 900 qm in an adjoining new building, move-in May 2008.
